What is Title I?

River's Edge Elementary is identified as a Title I school and part of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) of 2015. Title I is designed to support State and local school reform efforts tied to challenging state academic standards to reinforce and enhance efforts to improve teaching and learning for students. Title I programs must be based on an effective means of improving student achievement and include strategies to support parental engagement. All Title I schools must jointly develop a written parent and family engagement plan. Each year River's Edge Elementary School staff, parents, and community members jointly review and revise the R.E.E.S. Parent and Family Engagement Plan.

School Plan for Shared Student Achievement

What is it?

The River's Edge Parent and Family Engagement Plan is a jointly developed plan which describes how River's Edge Elementary School provides all parents with opportunities for improved parent engagement and support of student learning.
