Area of Emphasis by Grade

Second Grade Focus: Increase Math and Reading fluency.

Third Grade Focus: Introduction of writing processes required for GMAS success.

Fourth Grade Focus: Growth in each content area of 10% by all students.

Fifth Grade Focus: Overall growth in each content area for every student.
